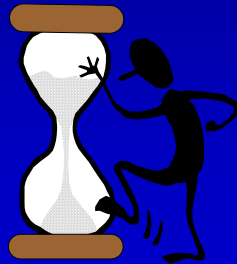

Service

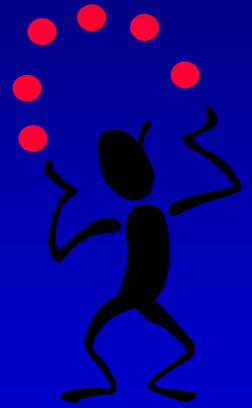
- Attending meetings
